Collections Guidelines

Entry

- **Entry Deadline:** May 26, Wednesday, 2010.
- **How to Enter:** Enter online at <http://ocfair.fairmanager.com>. (Printed forms are no longer available.)

Need assistance with the online entry? We have scheduled the following "Help Days."

May 17-20 (Monday–Thursday), 1pm to 7pm

May 24-25 (Monday–Tuesday), 1pm to 7pm

Parking: Enter at Gate 4 off Arlington Drive and go left inside the parking lot.

Location: New OC Fair Administration Building - Community Relations.

- **Who May Enter:** Youth (ages 9-18 on or before July 16, 2010) Divisions are open to Orange County residents only.
- **Entry Fees:** Entry fees are paid online by credit card (Visa, MasterCard or American Express). No refunds will be issued.
 - ♦ **YOUTH DIVISIONS** - \$3 per entry.
- **Entry Limit:**
 - ☛ **NEW THIS YEAR** - Maximum of **2 Collection** entries per person. A "Collection" is a minimum of 5 items and a maximum of 10 items. Collections on display boards or shadow boxes may exceed 10 items (e.g., pins, buttons, patches, etc.).
- **Free Fair Admission:** Exhibitors will receive one 2010 OC Fair admission ticket at time of entry delivery.

Delivery

- **Delivery Date:** This is the only time exhibits will be accepted.
 - ♦ **July 2, Friday; 7am – 9pm**
- **Where to Deliver Entries:** **NEW LOCATION** - Deliver all items for display directly to the Collections Gallery, Building 15. Report to the clerk at the Information Desk.
- **Claim Checks:** Will be provided when exhibits are delivered.
- **Setup of Exhibits:**
 - ♦ Only the exhibitor is allowed to set up his/her collection. No family members allowed on the exhibit floor.
 - ♦ Setup time is limited to 15 minutes.
 - ♦ Articles will be set up in designated area upon delivery for judging only. Judging is not based on how it is displayed on the table or in the case.
 - ♦ Spaces may vary. Display space subject to change
 - ♦ **No display props** - e.g., backdrops, platforms, material, easels, etc. No live plants.
 - ♦ All collections will be displayed after judging by OC Fair staff.

Pickup of Exhibits

- **Pickup Date:** August 17, Tuesday; Noon – 7pm
- **Claim Check:** Claim check or photo ID required for pickup.

Collections Guidelines cont.

Rules

- **Read Competition Guidelines:** Changes are made each year. Review the Collections Category Rules/Guidelines, Youth and OC Fair Guidelines (end of Youth Competition Guide).
- **REQUIRED: Please submit a photo of entire collection. Photo is for judging purposes only. Also submit an attractive, large print display card. Frames will be supplied for the display card.** Display card **must not** exceed 5" x 7" and should include the following information.
All information is very important in judging:
 - Date the collection was started.
 - How the collection was done (how collected).
 - Date (or dates) of oldest items in collection.
 - Number of items in the entire collection.
- Notify Coordinator in writing on a copy of the online entry receipt for any special display needs.
- There will be **no** Guns/Knives/Artillery displayed. Any of these items will be disqualified.
- Each collection item must be labeled inconspicuously with a number indicating its place in the collection (i.e. "1 of 10", "2 of 10", etc.) **DO NOT PLACE ON THE FRONT OF THE ITEM.**
- Pictures and articles to be hung must be wired and ready to be hung. Please, no saw-tooth hangers, masking tape, string, pop-top rings, etc. Improperly wired entries will not be accepted.
- Final acceptance of the entry will be left to the discretion of the collections Program Coordinator.
- Entries over the limit or any collections previously entered at the OC Fair will be disqualified.
- Collections on display boards or shadow boxes may exceed 10 items (e.g., pins, buttons, patches, etc.).
- Disqualified entries will not be displayed and **must** be picked up when notified.

Judging & Awards

- **Young Adults and Junior Divisions:** Are placed using the Danish Judging System where each entry is judged on how well it meets a standard rather than how it compares to other entries. Entries are judged Blue (superior), Red (very good) or White (average) Award. There may be more than one Blue, Red or White Award per class. All Blue Award Ribbons will compete, using the American Judging System, for cash awards.
- **Judges:** Qualified judge(s) will be selected by the Program Coordinator to judge all exhibits. The decision of the jurors is final.
- **Judging Results:** Results can be viewed online around the third week of Fair at <http://ocfair.com/results>. Please do not call for competition results.
- **Ribbons:** Exhibitors will receive awarded ribbons on entry pickup day.
- **Cash Awards:** Youth Divisions; Division Winner - \$25, Best of Show - \$35.
- **Award Checks:** Will be made payable to the exhibitor whose name is indicated on the entry form and mailed within 30 days after the close of the OC Fair.
- Judges and/or the Program Coordinator have the option of changing the requested category of a submitted entry. Classes or divisions may be combined to create an adequate judging pool.
